AUG 1 The Garden of Eden and the Fall

(Genesis 2:8-18,21-22; 3) **Brite Idea:** God hasn't given up on us. **Questions:** How does God feel about people? Why do people do wrong things? What should I do about the wrong things that I do? **Memory Verse:** Romans 6:23

AUG 8 Tower of Babel

(Genesis 11:1-9) Brite Idea: No one is greater than God. Questions: Is anyone greater than God? Do we get to decide who we want God to be? How important am I? Memory Verse: 1 Samuel 2:2

AUG 15 The Call of Abraham

(Genesis 12:1-9; 17:1-8) **Brite Idea:** God makes promises and keeps them. **Questions:** Can God be trusted? Do God's promises always happen right away? What promises has God made me? **Memory Verse:** Psalm 119:90

AUG 22 Brothers Reunited

(Genesis 32:3-33:11)

Brite Idea: God works even through difficult relationships. **Questions:** Is God bigger than people's broken relationships? How does God care for people who don't get along? How do I deal with people who don't get along with me? **Memory Verse:** John 16:33b

AUG 29 Joseph Becomes a Slave

(Genesis 37; 39:1-6) **Brite Idea:** God is always with us. **Questions:** Where is God when bad things happen? Are bad things a part of God's plan? How do I know that God is there? **Memory Verse:** Genesis 50:20a

Exodus & Promised Land

SEP 5 The Burning Bush

(Exodus 3-4:17)

Brite Idea: God shows us who He is. **Questions:** Does God want to be known? How can we trust who God says He is? How do I know God if I can't see Him?

SEP 12 The Tabernacle

Memory Verse: Deuteronomy 31:6

(Exodus 25: 8-9; 40) Brite Idea: God always makes a way to be with us. Questions: Where does God live? Why is God's presence special? How do I meet with God? Memory Verse: Exodus 29:46

SEP 19 Joshua and Jericho

(Joshua 5:13-6:27) **Brite Idea:** God leads His people. **Questions:** Who is God to us? How does God lead us? Why should I trust God to lead me? **Memory Verse:** Joshua 1:9

SEP 26 Judges

(Judges 2-3:15) Brite Idea: God helps and hears His people. Questions: What does God do for His people? How does God help us all the time? How do I ask God for help? Memory Verse: Psalm 28:7

(1 Samuel 13:1-14, 15:10-29) Brite Idea: God is the One True King. Questions: Can anyone take the place of God? Why should we be faithful to God? What if I want to make my own choices instead offollowing God's way? Memory Verse: Jeremiah 10:6

OCT 10 David and Jonathan

(1 Samuel 18:1-4; 19:1-7; 20:1-42) **Brite Idea:** God's plan comes first. **Questions:** Why does God's plan come first? How does God accomplish His plan? Who will support me as I grow in my relationship with God? **Memory Verse:** Psalm 33:11

OCT 17 Queen of Sheba

(1 Kings 10:1-13) **Brite Idea:** No one is wiser than God. **Questions:** Where does wisdom come from? How can we recognize wisdom from God? How can I become wiser? **Memory Verse:** Job 12:13

OCT 24 Elijah and the Contest

(1 Kings 18:1-3, 17-46) **Brite Idea:** God is really real. **Questions:** Is God real? Why should we believe that God is real? How should I live knowing that God is really real? **Memory Verse:** 1 Kings 18:39

OCT 31 Elisha and Naaman

(2 Kings 5:1-19)

Brite Idea: God can do things no one else can. **Questions:** What makes God so great? What should we do about how great God is? If God can do anything, why doesn't He do what I want Him to do? **Memory Verse:** Mark 10:27
