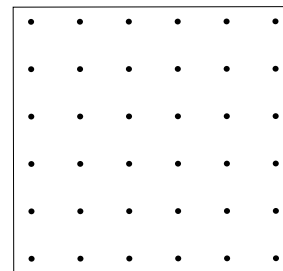
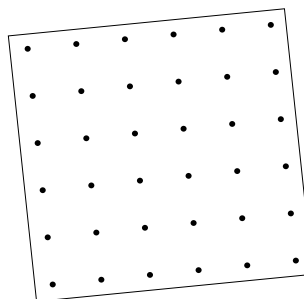
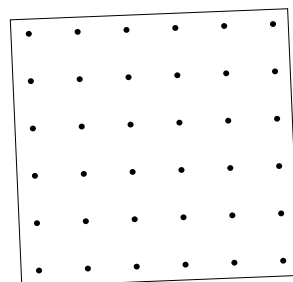
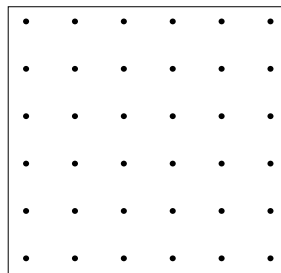
## FINISH THIS DRAWING
