DAY 1 - LIGHT AND DARK

Everyone take a a turn turning the flashlight on and off.

- When are some times that God makes light really bright?
- When is it really dark?
- How can we trust God when things are light and dark?
- Thank God for light.



DAY 2 - SKY AND WATER

Take turns pouring water from one cup into the other.

- How does God use weather to show us He is in control of water?
- Why is water important to us?
- How can we trust God when the weather is scary?
- Thank God for water and the sky.



DAY 3 - SUN, MOON AND STARS

Place a star sticker on the back of your hand.

- Why is the sun important to us?
- How do the sun, moon and stars help us remember that God is in control of the universe?
- Thank God for sun, moon and stars.



DAY 4 - LAND AND PLANTS

Use the spoon to scoop dirt from the tray to the cup.

- What are some of your favorite plants?
- How does the changing of the seasons remind us that God rules over our lives too?
- Thank God for land and plants.



DAY 5 - FISH AND BIRDS

Use the modeling dough to make a fish or a bird.

- What are some interesting birds or fish?
- God gave the birds and the fish the perfect habitat they needed. How can we trust God with where we live?
- Thank God for fish and birds.



DAY 6 - ANIMALS AND HUMANS

Pass around the small mirror so everyone can see their reflection.

- What are some cool things you know about how our body works?
- How can we trust God with our bodies?
- Thank God for animals and humans.



DAY 7 - GOD RESTED.

Set the timer and everyone sit quietly for one minute.

- How can resting show we trust God?
- Thank God for all of His creation and that we can trust that He is in control.



TAKE-HOME

CREATION

CREATION (GENESIS 1) The world was empty and formless. Then God spoke and created everything—light, sky, land, plants, sun, moon, animals, and people in His image. He called all creation good and still rules over it today.

POINT TO JESUS: Colossians 1:16-17 says Jesus created and holds all things together. He rules over all creation, yet He knows and loves each one of us.

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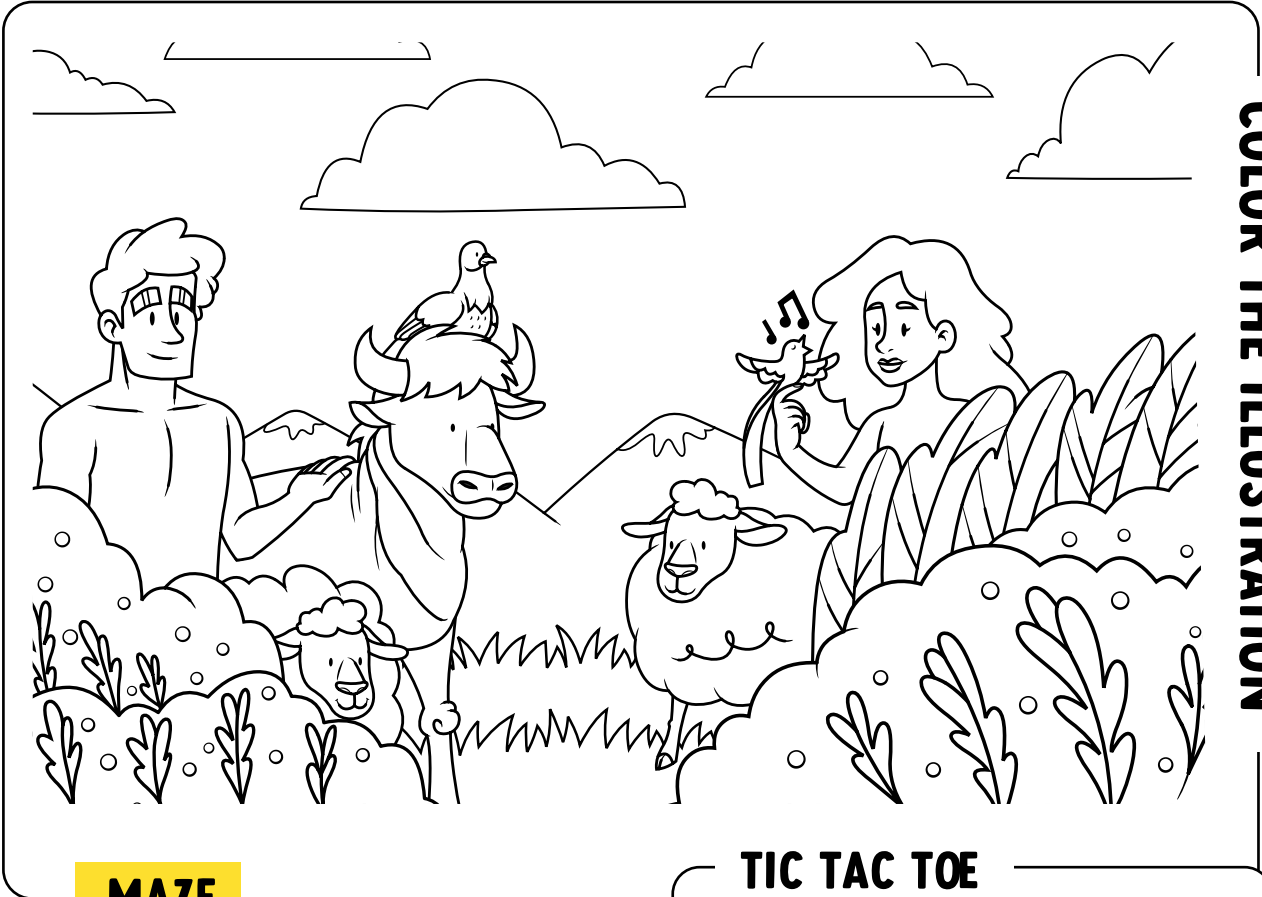
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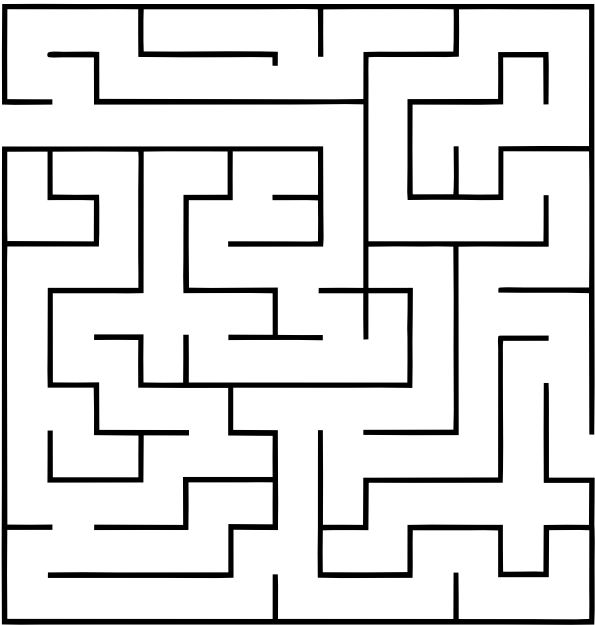
