

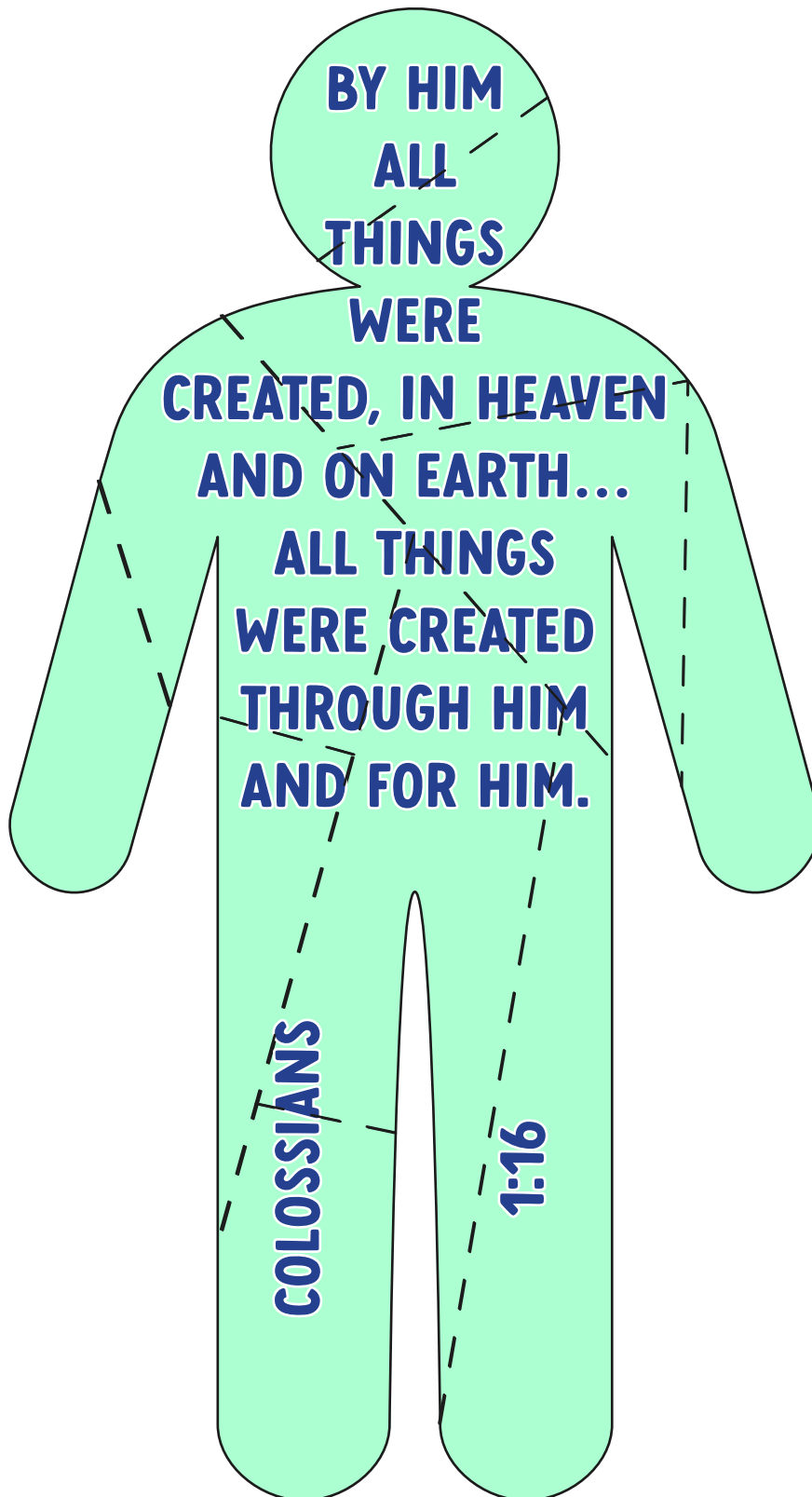

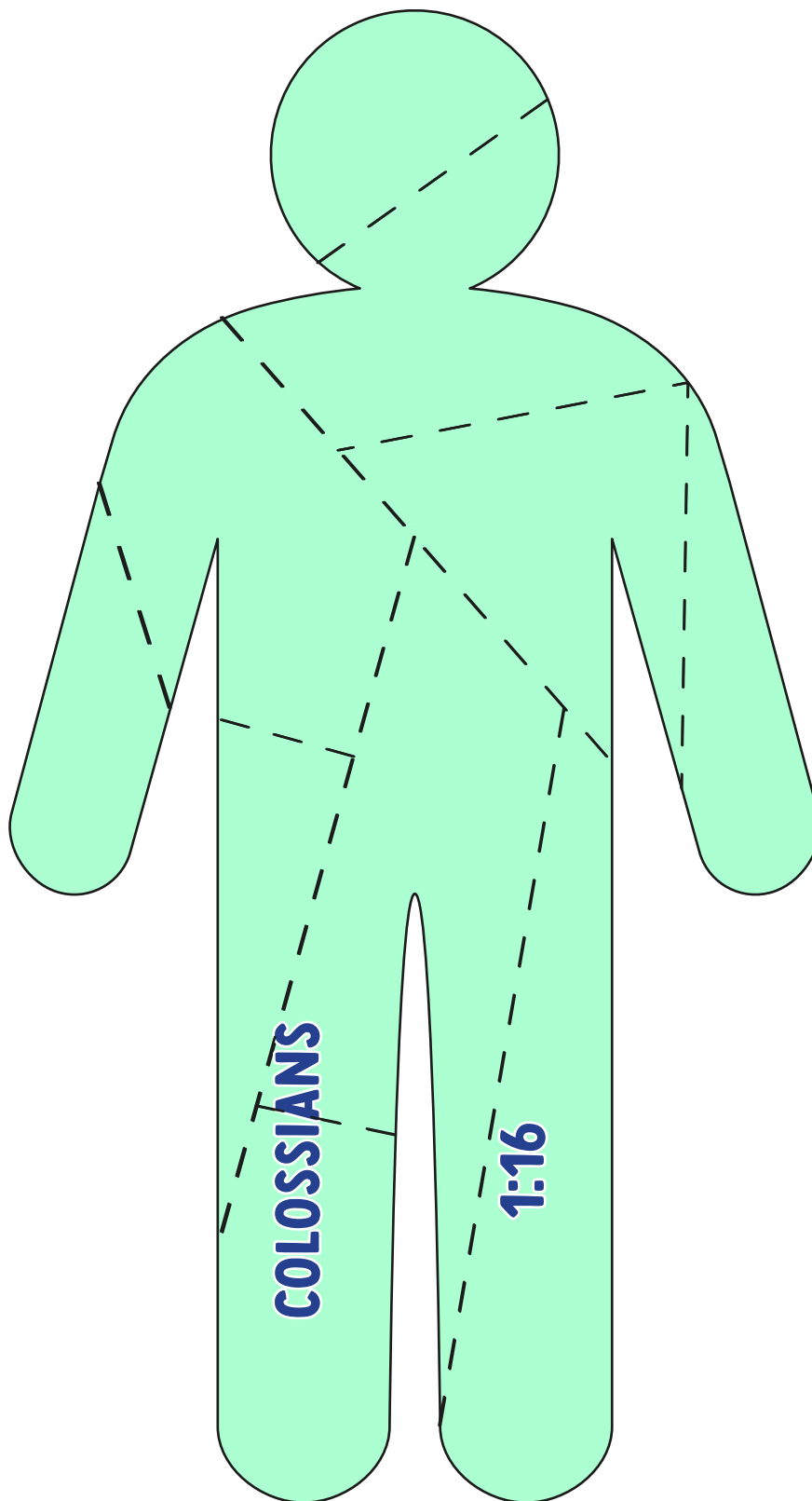

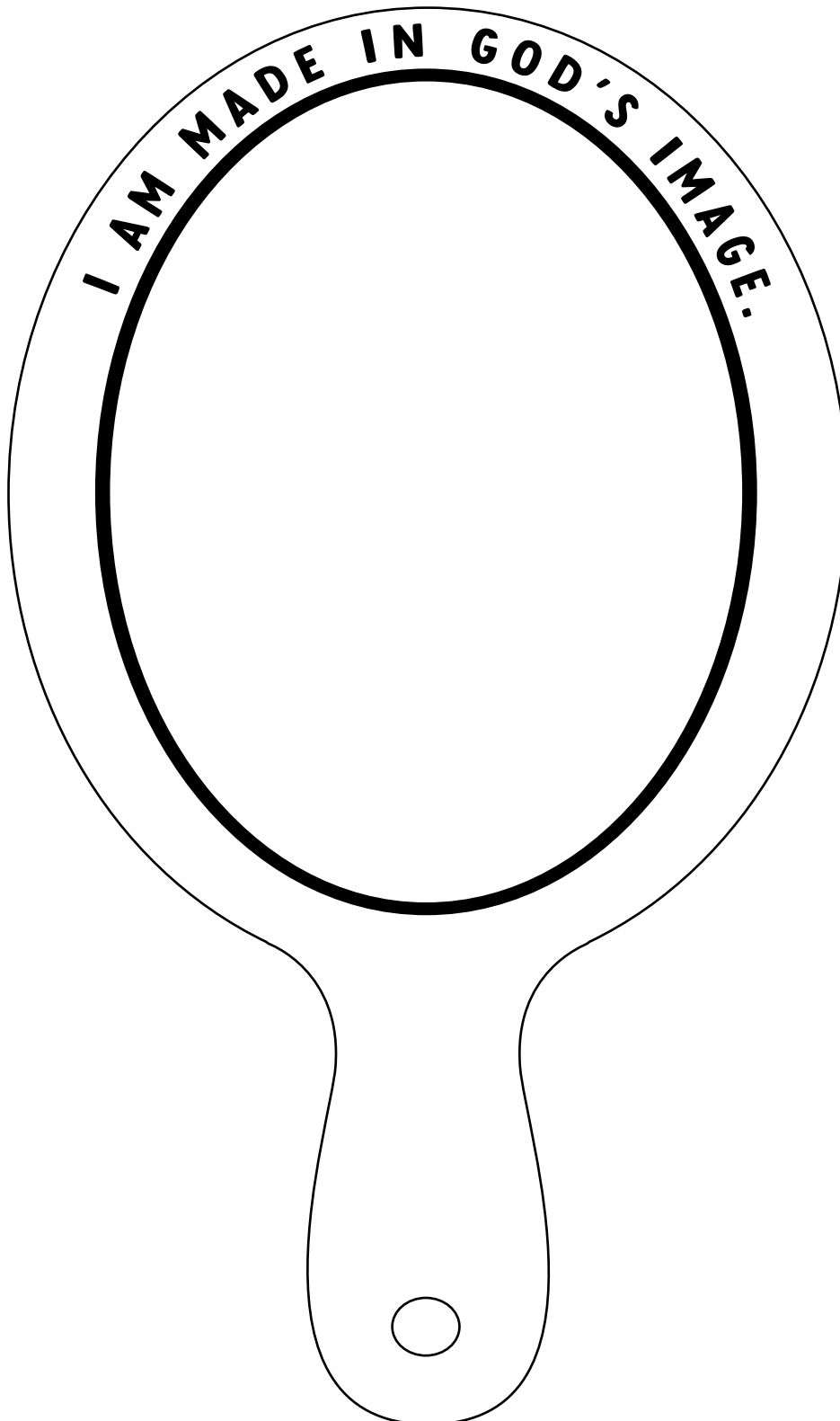

## Heart



**Say:** Place your hands over your heart. God loves you so much! He created you to have a friendship with you and to love you! Put your hands on your heart and pray and thank God for His love for you!

## Head



**Say:** Hold your hands on your head. God knows everything about you!

## Listen to Psalm 139:1-4



O Lord, You have searched me and known me!  
You know when I sit down and when I rise up;  
You discern my thoughts from afar.  
You search out my path and my lying down  
and are acquainted with all my ways.  
Even before a word is on my tongue,  
behold, O Lord, You know it altogether.

**Say:** The Bible even says the hairs on your head are numbered.

## Mouth

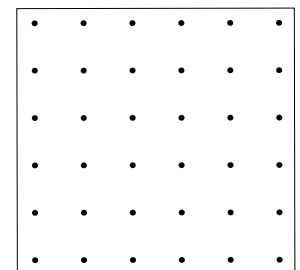
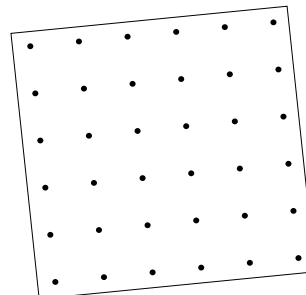
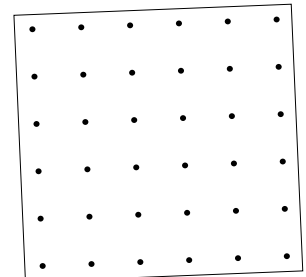
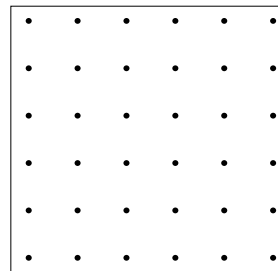
## FINISH THE PICTURE
