WHAT DOES MESSIAH MEAN?

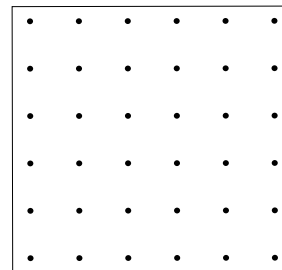
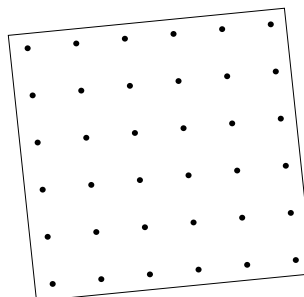
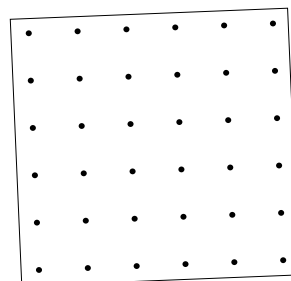
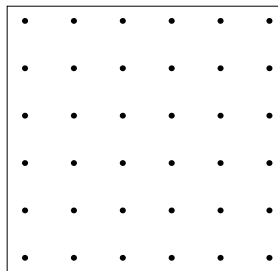
DOTS & BOXES
