The Great Commission (Matthew 28:16–20)

Week 1

Brite Idea: God calls us to tell others about Him.

He Question: What is the good news of Jesus?

God loves people but everyone is separated from Him by sin. God sent Jesus to be our Savior. Jesus died on the cross so we can be forgiven. If we trust in Jesus as our Savior, we can have eternal life.

We Question: What did Jesus command His followers to do?

Jesus commanded His followers to make disciples of all nations—to tell everyone the good news of Jesus. God wants every single person to have the opportunity to believe in Jesus.

God's Gospel Plan (Romans 10:9–15)

Week 2

Brite Idea: God uses believers to share His good news.

He Question: What is God's plan for the Gospel to be shared around the world?

God chose to use His people and His church to share the good news of Jesus with the whole world.

We Question: Whose responsibility is it to share the Gospel?

God calls every believer to share the good news about Jesus.

How to Share the Gospel (Colossians 4:2–6)

Week 3

Brite Idea: God calls us to be ready to share the Gospel.

He Question: What is the Gospel?

The Gospel is the good news that because God so loved the world, He sent His own Son, Jesus, to die on the cross to take the punishment for our sin. Jesus rose from the dead, making a way for us to be forgiven.

We Question: What does the Gospel mean for people?

When we believe in Jesus and trust in Him as our Savior, we aren't separated from God anymore. He makes us new and we can live with Him forever. God calls us to share the good news of the Gospel with everyone!

To the Ends of the Earth (John 3:16, Mark 16:15–16, Matthew 24:14)

Week 4

Brite Idea: God wants the entire world to know about Him.

He Question: Why does God care about the whole world?

God created every person in every nation and people group. He loves every single one. Jesus died on the cross for every person, everywhere.

We Question: How can we help share the Gospel throughout the world?

We can pray, support and encourage missionaries, as well as give and go ourselves.
