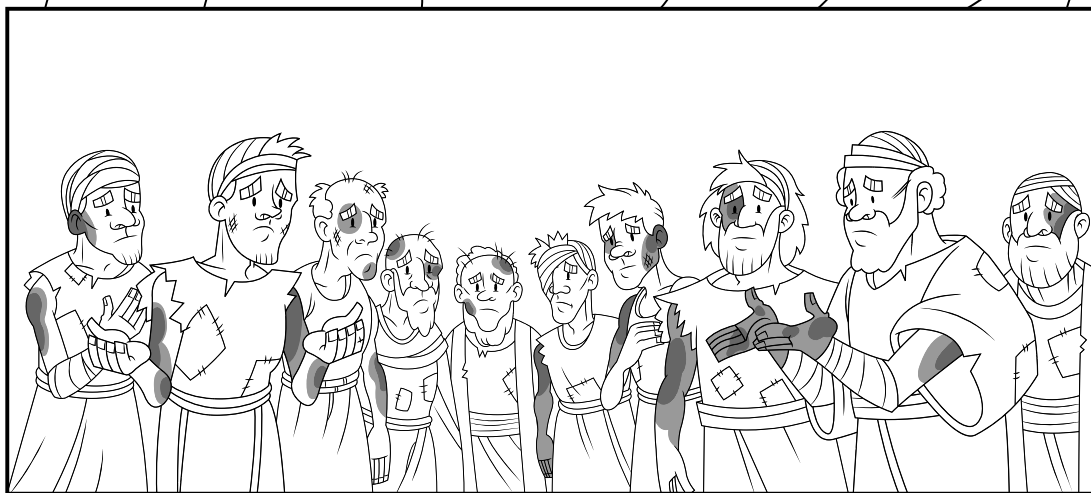

5. Can they guess your word before the stick man is complete?



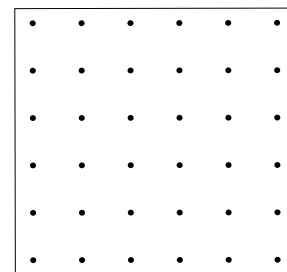
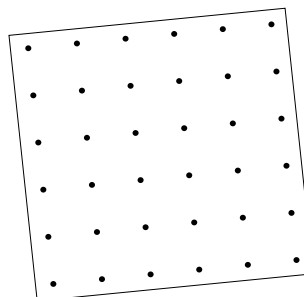
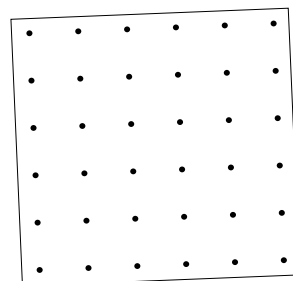
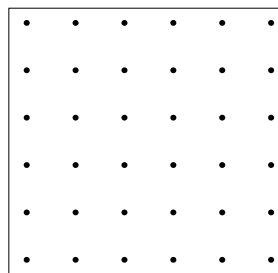
### DOTS & BOXES
