







## Trees/animals/nature:

**Say:** God created the world He made it perfect. Name something God created.



## Adam and Eve:

**Discuss:** What was His most important and precious creation? (People). He created people in His image, to be like Him. The people had a perfect relationship with God.

# SIN

## SIN in big letters:

**Say:** But unfortunately, the people disobeyed God and sin entered the world.


**Discuss:** What is sin? Sin is anything we think, say or do that disobeys God. Sin broke people's relationship with God and the consequence of that sin is forever separation from God.



## Heart:

**Say:** But God loved people so much that He couldn't let us be separated from Him forever.

**Discuss:** Who did God send to help us? God sent Jesus to live a perfect life. He never sinned.



## Cross:

**Discuss:** What did Jesus do for us? He died on the cross and instead of us getting the punishment for our sin, He took the punishment for us.



## Empty Tomb:

**Discuss:** Did Jesus stay dead? No! After three days, Jesus rose from the dead. He conquered sin and death.



## Two hands shaking:

**Say:** Now we can have a relationship with God. When we believe in Jesus as our Savior, we can live forever with God.









### STICK MAN
