DAVID IS CHOSEN	(1 Samuel 16)	Week 2

Brite Idea: God sees our hearts **He Question:** What does God know about us? God knows everything about people, but He does not act like humans do. He is most concerned about our hearts and who we truly are on the inside.

We Question: What is God looking for in us?

God desires for His people to seek after His heart. Loving God is more important than how we look or what we can do.

DAVID AND THE ARK (2 Samuel 5-6)

Brite Idea: God is worthy of worship. **He Question:** Why should God be worshiped?

God is our Creator, King, Savior and Promise Keeper. He deserves all of the praise and glory.

- We Question: How can we worship God?
- We can worship God through singing, prayer, serving and much more. Anything we do for His glory is worship.
- GOD'S COVENANT WITH DAVID (2 Samuel 7)

Brite Idea: God promised a forever King. **He Question:** Who is the promised forever King? Jesus is the King whom God promised would come from David's family. He is the Savior God promised in the Garden of Eden and to Abraham. He will reign forever.

We Question: Why do we need a forever King? Our sin separates us from God. We need a Rescuer to save us from our sin so we can live with Him forever. Because Jesus will never stop being King, we can trust His promise of rescuing us from sin is forever.
